LOVE TALE (GB) settled inside chasing the pace, split rivals on the second turn, came out in upper stretch and finished well. ROMANTIC WISH (GB) saved ground stalking the pace throughout and could not offer the needed late kick. PRETTYPRICEYGIRL stalked outside a rival, split horses with a forward move, bid alongside the runner-up on the backstretch and between horses into the second turn, was in a bit tight while falling back between foes into the stretch and weakened.
