MONGOL MAX broke sharply to gain the advantage between calls, continued under light reserve when joined on the pace attending his rival's tempo racing into the bend, was urged to dispute the issue between foes racing into upper stretch, was bumped, then carried inwards a bit nearing midstretch but gamely prevailed in the final stages, shifting into the path of MR. WATANABE TOO bumping that foe while regaining the advantage in time under strong left handed pressure. The latter stalked just off the first flight three deep under light rating in the opening stages, moved to force the issue in that path racing through the turn to upper stretch, shifted inwards under pressure bumping the eventual winner nearing midstretch and continued in a protracted skirmish to the wire while just failing to match terms when bumped approaching the wire. TRAVELIN HOME tracked off the first flight along the inside under light reserve, shifted out three deep entering the lane and continued with a mild bid to gain a share while failing to menace the top pair. BENNYFAX, a bit outpaced early, gained some position between foes in late stages while making no real impression. MAGGIE'S BEST, urged to dispute the pace inside a rival in the opening quarter, dueled for command inside foes into upper stretch and gave way. BINGORUN, reserved outside foes tracking the leaders from out of striking distance, raced four wide into the lane and never seriously menaced.
